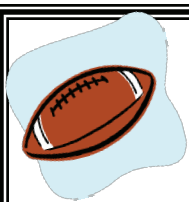

The next Parish Stewardship Fair is Sept 14th. Please let Kathy Baker know if you are interested in helping staff the booth. Smiling faces always needed!!

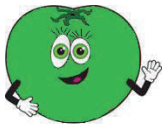
**Annual Banquet**—Mark your calendars today—**September 16, TUESDAY, @ 7pm.**

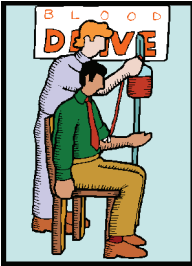

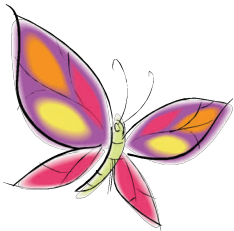

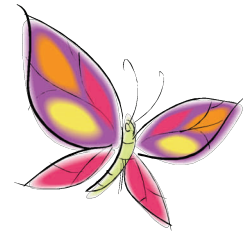
