New Opportunity for Council 5253

The following was proposed as new business at the business meeting in May.
After publication in the June newsletter, it will be discussed and voted on at the business meeting in June.

Motion Proposed: That the council allocate up to \$20,000 to the newly formed Community Festival committee to find, negotiate and purchase a Concession Trailer for use at local community festivals and events. The committee will develop and present a business plan for the June business meeting.

Proposed that the funds be drawn from the Building Corps as a loan, with 1/2 of the proceeds from community events to be used first to pay back the loan over a period not to exceed 10 years. The remaining net proceeds will be returned to the council general funds.

Recommendation from the Festival Committee: There are a number of members who currently participate in local community festivals and generate goodwill and income to the council. We currently use a borrowed trailer that is not always available. Having our own trailer will enable the council to paint it with K of C logos for increased visibility in the community, and allow more flexibility to schedule additional events in Reynoldsburg and the surrounding communities. The committee has explored used Concession Trailers available for sale and believes that a quality trailer can be purchased and outfitted for less than \$20,000. The committee has secured commitments for a truck to haul the trailer, a storage site for the trailer, and individuals to support upcoming events in Reynoldsburg and Pataskala.

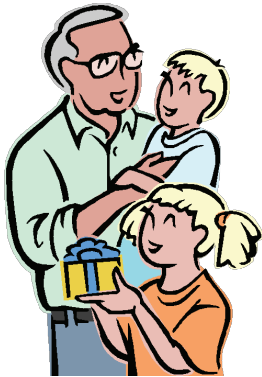
